

THE WALLPAPER HISTORY SOCIETY STUDENT AND RESEARCH BURSARY - GUIDELINES

The Trustees of the Wallpaper History Society offer a bursary of £1,000 per year to support both historical research and developments in the conservation of historic wallcoverings

- The bursary is available to postgraduate students studying at a UK college or university, or private researchers of an appropriate academic level/publishable level, living in the UK. Applicants are invited to fill in the relevant application form outlining their project or research proposal. This should be a piece of original research which may concern any aspect of the history of wallcoverings; for example their trade, usage, design, or concerning their conservation.
- The Wallpaper History Society is committed to the continual furthering of knowledge in this field and would therefore require the successful applicant to provide an article or report on their work. The successful candidate would be expected to provide the WHS with additional rights to publish the article in the Wallpaper History Society Review or any other publication nominated by the Society. In this vein, unsuccessful applicants may also be approached to be given the opportunity to submit their work for publication in the Wallpaper History Society Review or any other publication nominated by the Society.
- The Bursary will be given over a period of 12 months: A first instalment of £500 will be awarded after 6 months, upon receipt by the Society, of a satisfactory progress report. The second and final instalment of £500 will be given at the end of the 12 month period, on completion of the relevant project/research or agreed part thereof.
